




Agnesi 1799: The meaning on the label

1. Maria Gaetana Agnesi: Brilliant 18th century mathematician, philosopher, and theologian. A known prodigy and fluent in seven languages by her eleventh birthday, she was the first woman to write a mathematics handbook and also the first female mathematics professor at a university.
2. Her mathematical “witch” equation won her immediate acclaim in academic circles all over Europe.
3. The Witch of Agnesi. The most famous curve in the world. Today applied to things such as the bell curve.
4. 1799, the year of her death.
5. Five year old small batch American brandy.
6. Blended in partnership with some of California’s oldest, artisanal brandy houses.
7. Proofed with pristine Napa spring water.
8. The “Witch of Agnesi” was originally called “versiera” which means “to turn.” Unfortunately, due to a mistranslation, it became the “Witch.”
